CVC 38304 & cvc38304.1:	
All customers operating vehicles shall be able to reach and operate all controls necessary to safely operate the vehicle. Neither a parent or guardian of a child who is under 14 years of age, nor and adult who is authorized by the parent or guardian to supervise that child, shall grant permission to, or knowingly allow, that child to operate an off-highway motor vehicle which they cannot reach and operate all controls necessary to safely operate the vehicle.	
CVC 38503 (b): Initial	
All customers under age 18 operating ATV's value Certificate/Card shall be under the direct supervision of an a Safety Certificate/Card issued by this state, or issued under	adult that posses an appropriate
CVC 38503 (c):	
All customers under age 18 operating ATV's wadult that possess an appropriate Safety Certificate/Card, sappropriate Safety Certificate/Card.	
CVC 38504: Initial	
All customers under age 14 operating ATV's shall be under the direct supervision of an adult who is authorized by the parent or guardian. The adult or the customer under age 14 must possess an appropriate Safety Certificate/Card.	
CVC 38506: Initial	
All customers riding ATV's are not allowed to carry passengers unless the ATV was designed for operation with an operator and a passenger.	
Initial	
Wearing helmets, chest protectors, gloves, goggles, knee and elbow pads, long pants, long sleeve shirt or jacket, and over the ankle boots will greatly reduce risk of injury.	
All ATV operators are required to wear a strapped or fastened helmet whenever operating an ATV.
